

Enrolment Criteria

Hukarere Girls' College is a secondary school established for the education of girls in a Māori and Mihinare Christian setting. It is a school where Te Ao Māori upheld and spiritual education is based on Oranga Ake o Te Iwi and a commitment to biblical principles revealed in the life and teachings of Jesus Christ.

Under the integration agreement with the Ministry of Education (MOE) for enrolment at Hukarere Girls College. Preferential enrolment is given to;

- 1. Whānau who have a connection and affiliation with the Haahi Mihinare or special connection to the Special Character by thoroughly belonging to a Christian Church with similar biblical basis of faith doctrine.
- 2. Students of Māori descent.
- 3. Students with siblings at the school.
- 4. Students whose parents are on the staff of the college.

Subject to places being available, the College Deed of Integration Agreement with the MOE requires that no more than 10% of the roll can be to non-preferential students when they have no connection or affiliation to the Haahi or Special Character of the college by belonging to other Christian Churches.

Te Aute Trust Board as Proprietors

- Makes an investment in support of each equal to the school fees charged to attend Hukarere Girls' College. This includes resources, activities and opportunities for all students (boarders and day students).
- has final sign off on all enrolments to ensure the commitment to Oranga Ake o Te lwi is held by all students and whānau.

Enrolment Requirements

Whānau are to provide the following;

- 1. A letter of reference from their sons previous school Principal/Teacher speaking to their character, achievements (academic, sporting, cultural, spiritual), commitment to learning, behaviour, attitude and suitability to a Mihinare Māori boarding college environment.
- 2. The latest school academic report for the student.
- 3. A completed application form stating extra-curricular interests, personal interests & achievements and any possible challenges moving away from home.
- 4. A letter from the student stating why they wish to come to Hukarere Girls' College, what their expectations are and what they bring with them from their previous school and whanau life.

Upon receiving all enrolment requirements, enrolment spaces will be prioritised for those applications that thoroughly align with Hukarere Girls' College Special Character.

There is a requirement that whānau and their daughter understand that they will be attending a school of Māori Mihinare Special Character and that they will commit to supporting by active and positive participation in the values, programmes and ethos of the school.

Final decisions about the acceptance of enrolment will be made by the Principal, in consultation with college leadership, using this enrolment criteria. The Hukarere Girls' College Board will also be consulted as required.

Agreement
